

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF DOMESTIC NONPROFIT CORPORATION

The person acting as the incorporator under the provisions of Title 29 of the D.C. Code adopts the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE 1. NAME

The name of this Corporation is Onward Together.

ARTICLE 2. MEMBERS

This Corporation shall have members. The classes of members, the qualifications of the members of each class, and the rights of the members of each class shall be established by the Bylaws of the Corporation.

ARTICLE 3. REGISTERED AGENT'S NAME AND ADDRESS

The name and address of this Corporation's initial registered agent is CT Corporation Services, 1015 15th Street NW, Suite 1000, Washington, DC 20005.

ARTICLE 4. NONPROFIT INCORPORATION

This Corporation is incorporated as a nonprofit corporation under D.C. Code Title 29, Chapter 4.

ARTICLE 5. INDEMNIFICATION

The Corporation reserves the power to indemnify a Director who is a party to a proceeding because he or she is or was a Director, for judgments, settlements, penalties, fines, including excise taxes assessed with respect to employee benefit plans, or reasonable expenses (including attorneys' fees) incurred with respect to a threatened, pending, or completed proceeding, except liability for:

- 1. Receipt of a financial benefit to which the Director is not entitled;
- 2. An intentional infliction of harm;

- 3. A violation of D.C. Code § 29-406.33 or a successor provision of law; or
- 4. An intentional violation of criminal law.

ARTICLE 6. LIMITATION OF LIABILITY

A Director shall not be liable to the Corporation or its members for money damages for any action taken, or any failure to take action, as a Director, except liability for:

- 1. The amount of a financial benefit received by the Director to which the Director is not entitled;
- 2. An intentional infliction of harm;
- 3. A violation of District of Columbia Code § 29-406.33 or a successor provision of law; or

4. An intentional violation of criminal law.
