Articles of Incorporation

of

The Upper Rio FM Society, Inc. CORPORATION AND
FRANCHISE TAX DEPTS.

We, the undersigned, acting as incorporators of a corporation under the New Mexico Nonprofit Act, adopt the following articles of incorporation for such corporation:

First: The name of the corporation is The Upper Rio FM Society, Inc.

Second: The period of its duration is perpetual.

Third: The purpose for which the corporation is organized is to operate a nonprofit corporation for educational and scientific purposes as follows:

- (a) to educate and increase the proficiency of its members in the science of radio communication.
- (b) to provide for dissemination of information among its members concerning scientific advancement and progress in the field of radio communications.
- (c) to organize and train units of licensed radio amateurs capable of maintaining radio communication as a public service during periods of emergency.
- (d) to encourage and sponsor experimental activities in radio communications and electronics to the end that skills and experience gained in amateur radio will further the application of electronics to the benefit of the public at large.
- (e) to promote the elevation of standards of practice and ethics in the conduct of amateur radio communication.

Fourth: The corporation shall have and exercise in accordance with these articles of incorporation and its bylaws, and in a manner not inconsistent with law, all rights and powers including the power to contract, rent, buy, or sell personal or real property, provided, however, that the corporation shall not, except to an insubstantial degree, engage in any activities or exercise any powers that are not in furtherance of the purposes of the corporation.

Fifth: The property of the corporation is irrevocably dedicated to educational and scientific purposes and of its net income or assets shall ever inure to the

of any director, officer, or member thereof or to the benefit of any private individual, and, upon the dissolution or final liquidation of the corporation, its assets, remaining after the payment of or provision for the payment of all its debts and liabilities, shall be distributed to similarly purposed organizations which are organized and operated exclusively for educational and scientific purposes and which have established their tax exempt status under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.
